

### **PD1 Volunteer Overview:**

PD1 is a dynamic soccer program focused on nurturing a passion for the sport and offering rewarding experiences beyond the game itself. As a PD1 volunteer, you'll have the chance to take on different roles that help uphold the program's goals and make a positive difference in the lives of participants. PD1 volunteers will report to the PD1 Volunteer Coordinator position who will be available for comments, questions, or concerns. PD1 volunteers will be given a special volunteer PD1 T-shirt to wear during volunteer events.

## Responsibilities

Category One: Soccer Players

- Lead by Example: Attend PD1 sessions ready to play and demonstrate soccer skills, serving as a role model for aspiring players.
- Mentorship: Share your knowledge and expertise with the next generation of soccer enthusiasts through engaging LifeTalks and unique training session drills.
- Skill Development: Assist in conducting drills and exercises designed to enhance players' technical abilities, tactical understanding, and overall performance.
- Encouragement: Provide encouragement, motivation, and constructive feedback to players, inspiring them to strive for excellence and reach their full potential.
- Player Development: Contribute to the development of players' confidence, teamwork, and sportsmanship both on and off the field.

#### Category Two: Administrative Duties

- Set-Up and Take-Down: Assist in the setup and takedown of equipment and facilities before and after PD1 sessions, ensuring a safe and organized environment for participants.
- Photography: Capture memorable moments and highlights during PD1 events, helping to document the program's impact and showcase the achievements of participants.
- Registration: Support the registration process by assisting participants with sign-ups, collecting necessary information, and ensuring smooth logistics.
- Event Coordination: Assist in coordinating logistics for PD1 events, including scheduling, communication with participants, and coordination of resources.
- Community Engagement: Act as ambassadors for PD1 within the community, promoting the program's values and opportunities for involvement.
